Chairman Jim Locke called the meeting to order at 7:05PM.

1. Charles Dudek told the Board that the Energy Committee is working on submissions for one or more grants from the state Green Communities program. He asked if the Planning Board wanted to be part of that process. The members discussed whether the Board should have any formal role in this process. The consensus was that the Board would not formally participate. Jim Locke said he would be available to represent the Board if needed when the topic comes up at the next Select Board meeting.
2. The members reviewed minutes from the meeting on December 2, 2013. Bob Barker moved to accept the minutes with an amendment to fix a typo in "Locke." Charles Dudek seconded and the minutes were accepted unanimously.
3. After reviewing minutes from December 9, 2013, Barker moved to accept the minutes with an amendment to fix a typo of repeated words, "known to the known." Charles Dudek seconded and the minutes were accepted unanimously.
4. Chairman Locke engaged the Board in a discussion of what larger topics the Board should next take up. He shared the list below from the December 2 meeting:

Sign bylaws and enforcement	Applications streamlined
Zoning for light industry	Zoning to keep open spaces
Developable vs preserved zones	Support for elderly
CPA - good idea, what to do with funds	Sewer expansion - PB roles in decisions
Regularizing regulations and ZBA/PB roles	Supporting agriculture

The consensus after discussion was that the next topic the Board would work on would be clarification of the roles of the ZBA and the Planning Board.
