

Minutes of Williamsburg Water/Sewer Commission
September 22, 2010

Members of the Water/Sewer Commission met in regular session on Wednesday, September 22, 2010 @ 7:00 P.M. The Chairman called the meeting to order and upon roll call the following were present: Walter Kellogg-Chairman, Ken Taylor-Clerk, Howard Sanderson, & Brenda Lessard, Secretary.

1. Motion made by Ken Taylor to accept minutes of 9/8/10. Seconded by Howard Sanderson. Motion so voted.
2. Motion made by Howard Sanderson to accept warrants of September 29, 2010 . Seconded by Ken Taylor. Motion so voted.
3. Overlook @ Northampton Update- The samples have finally come back clean. Sam has been up to Overlook everyday to check the progress. Parts are ordered but work has stalled. He will keep going to check progress as the deadline is October 15th for the extension granted from DEP.
4. Ken Taylor noted that the generators have come but they will need some work.
5. Brenda handed out a started draft of the Rules & Regulations book. Sam wants it noted that access to meters needs to be addressed in the regulations.
6. Ken Taylor reported that the Unquomok Dam area has been cut. It is very dry at the dam. Sam Kellogg noted that the swamp area by the wells is dried up also. The water ban should stay intact for now.
7. Ken Taylor reported that the water main leak on Route 9 is fixed. An old service connection that went nowhere was leaking. The pipe was cut and plugged.
8. Ken Taylor wants a letter of thanks to go to Mass Rural Water thanking Mike Leach for helping to locate the leak on Route 9. Without his assistance the leak would have been difficult to locate and would have taken a lot more time.
9. Motion to adjourn at 8:45 pm was made by Ken Taylor. Motion seconded by Howard Sanderson. So voted.
