We are still being instructed by DEP to continue chlorinating but to decrease the concentration.

- 7. Timber bids are going out with a deadline for bids to be 7:00 pm on 12/1/10. Bids will be opened on 12/1/10 at the meeting. The commission would like smaller equipment used.
- 8. There are two seminars coming up. The members looked at them. They will decide if anyone would like to go.
- 9. Bill Turner is still working on the beaver issue off South Street up by the well house. A call was received by a neighbor that water was backing up onto her property due to the beavers.
- 10. Motion was made by Howard Sanderson to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by William Turner. Meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
